

Year 3 Home Learning Spring 2

Our Year 3 weekly home learning expectations are:-

Read your school **banded reading book five times per week**. Each home read should be logged in your reading diary.
Develop your times tables fluency using Times Table Rockstars. By the end of year 3 children should be confident in their 3s, 4s, 6s and 8s, having learnt their 2s, 5s and 10s in KS1.

Spellings are issued each week by mid-week and are tested on Monday the following week.

You are also expected to complete at least one of these projects which you will bring in to present to the class.

The deadline for these to be in school is **Monday 25th March 2024** – this is so that we can share our work in class from **Wednesday 27th March 2024**.

Maths

Practise your 3, 4 and 8 times table. Write some word problems for someone else to solve using these times tables. Mark their answers!

PSHE

Design a poster about how to keep safe online.

Design & Technology

Draw a poster with examples of wearable technology used in your household. Include the following information: function of the technology (what does it do) and what it helps or makes easier for the user.

OR

With permission from your adult, experiment with coding a virtual Micro:bit to flash at **makecode.microbit.org/** Take a screenshot to show us what you achieved.

English

Write a short story about helping someone to learn about road safety.

OR

Write a newspaper report about Max Hedgehog's research into road safety.

Science

Create a poster explaining how plants make their own food.

Geography

Make an active volcano! Write a set of instructions to make an erupting volcano.

OR

Create a poster about something you have found interesting in our volcanoes topic – for example, the different types of tectonic plates and what they do.
