Learn your spellings each week.

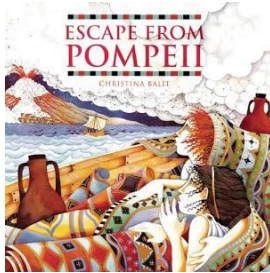

Make a list of all the reasons the Romans wanted to invade Britain and put them in order of importance.

Create a quiz about the Romans for your friends or family to complete.



Art

Create a 3D sculpture using whatever materials you can find around your house. You could use kitchen roll tubes, cereal boxes, unwanted envelopes or cards to create a range of shapes for your model. You could make your model into whatever design you like.



Science

Create an encyclopaedia page about light or the sun.

Think about how light travels.
How do we see?

Can you research about animals who can't see and find out why?
