Read your school reading book five times per week.

English

Create a comic strip of a person arriving in an unfamiliar environment. What will they see? Where do they go? Who do they meet? How are they feeling?

<u>Maths</u>

Create your own SATs revision guide suitable for Year 6. Think carefully about the essential knowledge that will help the next Year 6 pupils survive SATs – ask your teacher if you want to!

Explain, give examples and provide sample questions for the different concepts you have learnt about.

Geography

Research and create a presentation (either as a poster or on PowerPoint) about a well-known earthquake,

e.g. San-Francisco, Japan, Turkey.

Explain why it happened, the destruction it caused and what has been done since to help reduce the damage of any future earthquakes in that area. Also, remember to give key facts such as measurement on Mercalli Scale, etc.

Science/ Design and Technology

Create a musical instrument. Consider carefully how it will produce sound. How will the sound be manipulated?
