Super Heroes

Maths

- Recognising the value of 1p and 10p coins and making amounts of money using these coins.
- Solve problems involving length and height.
- Addition and subtraction and represent number bonds to 20 and related subtraction facts.
- Count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.
- Recognise, half of a shape or quantity.
- Recognise common 2D and 3 D shapes.

History

Changes over time – Toys

Understanding that toys have changed over time, mainly in terms of materials used to make them/ technology for powering/driving them.

Children will see that their parents'/ grandparents' generations played active games or participated in more outdoor activities than today.

Understanding that in the past most children had far fewer toys than children today.

- Knowing the different types of animals – fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Understanding how animals feed, move and use their senses to survive.
