A-Z animal list. Can you think of an animal that begins with each letter of the alphabet? Sound out each word using the phonics you have learnt. If you are able to, try to add sound buttons underneath the words.

Creative

Take inspiration from our text drivers 'The Rainbow Fish,' 'The Lion Inside' and 'Mr Tiger Goes Wild' design an animal puppet or mask.



Science

Having learnt about the properties of materials, make a poster about properties and uses of different materials. This could be photos/pictures of objects and labels to say what it is made from and the properties of the material.
