## Maths

## History

Through your own research and your learning in the classroom, create a fact file on the topic of 'Saxons and Scots'. This could be created as a booklet or PowerPoint presentation.

or

Using your imagination, could you create a comic strip which shows the journey (the adventure) that an item of food travels when passing through the human digestion system.
