Our Year 6 weekly home learning expectations are:-

Read your school reading book five times per week. Develop your times tables fluency using Times Table Rockstars Learn your spellings each week.

Extra Maths practise may also be given out when necessary to consolidate concepts taught during the week. You are also expected to complete at least one of these projects which you will bring in to present to the class. The deadline for these to be in school is Monday 11th December 2023.

<u>English</u>

Create a graphic novel based on a journey through a fantasy world.

Write a diary based on someone who is stranded in the Amazon rainforest and their story of survival.

<u>History</u>

Create a guide or a tour through a castle. Write about the various features of a castle and give an explanation. Alternatively, you could investigate and present how castles changed over time, or even create your own model of a castle!

Design and Technology

Design and create a Christmas stocking using materials and running stiches to decorate.

<u>Computing</u>

Create a coded quiz or game based on any of our Year 6 topics and designed for children in KS2. It will need different levels and a points system or reward for success.

<u>Science</u>

Animal adaptations: Create a presentation/report that explains how a certain animal has adapted to its environment and how it has evolved.

Create a report that explores an extinct species of animal and the reasons for its extinction.
