We intend to use our allocation of £7160.00 in the following ways:

Sports Grant Premium 2017 - 2018	Intended outcomes for pupils
Widen the range of sporting opportunities for all pupils across the school, within the school day. This will be through weekly lessons delivered by the class teacher and sports coaches.	Pupils will have opportunity to participate in a variety of sports activities throughout the year including multi-skills, tag rugby, cricket, netball and gymnastics.
Increase school and individual pupil participation in competitions and tournaments across the region to include transport where necessary and coaching support.	Pupils will be provided with opportunities to compete competitively against other schools in a range of sports. The school will be represented at local and regional competitions. Pupils will have opportunity to play competitively.
Provide high quality coaching for pupils through partnership work with a local sports provider. This will include cricket coaching and tag rugby.	All pupils will receive coaching sessions with external sports coaches throughout the school year.
Provide CPD opportunities for teaching staff in the delivery of gymnastics and athletics. (Anton Junior School sports outreach)	Increase confidence and expertise for teaching staff which will impact on quality of teaching and learning.
Provision of additional after school clubs in sport. To include this will include football, athletics, netball and multi-skills.	Pupils will have opportunity to learn new skills through participation as well as improve health and well-being through physical activity.
Subscription to Basingstoke Sports Partnership	Widen range of sporting opportunities off site – training or competitive. Develop links with other schools, increase social and sporting opportunities for children attending events.
Purchase of additional PE resources to support effective teaching and learning in PE.	Teachers will be able to deliver high quality lessons with appropriate resources. Children will be able to access learning with appropriate resources.
Provide a football club and further sports activities at lunchtimes, run by Sports Coaches employed by the school.	Increased opportunities for active play for all children. Increased leadership responsibilities for Year 6 pupils to lead games and activities under guidance of lunchtime games leader.
Investigate the introduction of Young Sports Leaders for Year 5 and Year 6 pupils. (training to be developed/provided by external sports coaches)	Provides additional responsibility for selected pupils. Increases sports opportunities for the rest of the school through activities led by Young Leaders at lunchtimes.

How will the impact of this funding be measured?

The school will conference pupils, staff members and governors in the Spring term 2018.

The annual parental survey Spring 2018 will request feedback about sports provision and impact.
